

ARPA Funding for Education and the 2021/22 State Budget

The 2021/22 budget package appropriated and provided the distribution for federal relief funding for education from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

Reminder: Pennsylvania law (Section 6104(d) of Act 17A of 2020) requires certain federal funding for COVID-19 relief to be appropriated by the General Assembly.

ARPA included a \$122.8 billion third round of Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funding. Pennsylvania’s share was \$5 billion, to be spent by September 2024, with the following breakdown:

- Per federal law, 90% or \$4.5 billion had to be sent to school districts and charter schools proportionally based upon the federal Title I, Part A formula. These funds did not need to be appropriated by PA’s General Assembly.
- The remaining 10% or \$500 million was available for state-directed activities, but there were some requirements. These funds had to be appropriated by the PA General Assembly.

The table below shows how the \$500 million in state-directed ARPA ESSER funds were allocated in the 2021/22 fiscal code (HB1348). Estimates by local education agency follow on the indicated pages.

Additionally, HB1348 put minimum requirements on the \$250 million in learning loss funds: at least 30 percent must be used to address the social, emotional, and mental health needs of students; 10 percent must go toward professional development related to providing for the social, emotional, and mental health needs of students; and 8 percent is to be reserved for reading remediation and improvement.

Other Federal Relief Funding for Education through ARPA:

- Appropriated funds:
 - \$152.7 million for Emergency Assistance to Non-public Schools (EANS II). Non-public schools must apply to PDE for these funds.
 - PA received \$4.79 million in ARPA funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services. HB1348 provided the distribution of these dollars to Public Libraries (see estimates on pages 41-45).
- Funds that did not require an appropriation:
 - \$32.7 million to assist homeless students
 - \$104.8 million for IDEA programs
