#### How to Read the Spreadsheet: 'Impact of Gov. Corbett's Education Choices on School Districts'

The attached spreadsheet compares, by school district, Gov. Corbett's cumulative classroom education funding under his four-year tenure to 2008/09 (the year prior to federal stimulus funding) and 2010/11 funding levels (the year before Gov. Corbett took office).

Under Gov. Corbett's tenure, schools districts have received more than \$22 billion in the five classroom education subsidies, a dramatic cut as described below.

- Had the governor flat-funded the education appropriations at the 2008/09 level, the districts would have received roughly \$23 billion, or nearly \$900 million more, over his tenure.
- Had Gov. Corbett flat-funded the appropriations at the 2010/11 level, the districts would have received roughly \$25 billion, or nearly \$3 billion more, over his tenure.

#### **How to Read the Spreadsheet - By Example**

Using the Philadelphia City School District, the commonwealth's largest district serving roughly 11.5 percent of all public school students as an example:

- Philadelphia City School District's average expenditure per student = \$13,167
  - This is nearly \$1,000 less than the statewide average per student of \$14,127. Statewide expenditures per student range from \$9,530 to \$30,729.
- Philadelphia City School District's aid ratio = 0.7262
  - The district's aid ratio is above the average aid ratio of 0.5530, which means the district is poorer than the average school district. Aid ratios range from 0.1500 (the lowest level for the wealthiest school districts) to 0.8807 (poorest districts).
- Total classroom funding for Philadelphia City School District during Gov. Corbett's tenure = \$4.02 billion
  - Had Gov. Corbett flat-funded Philadelphia City School District's education appropriations at the 2008/09 level, the district would have received \$4.6 billion over his tenure a loss of \$590.9 million or \$2,930 per student.
  - Had Gov. Corbett flat-funded Philadelphia City School District's education appropriations at the 2010/11 level, the district would have received \$5.14 billion over his tenure a loss of \$1.12 billion or \$5,547 per student.

# **How to Read the Spreadsheet - By Column**

#### **Blue Columns**

- School districts are organized alphabetically by county.
  - The eight financially distressed school districts are indicated with an emboldened and italic font.
  - The school districts highlighted in pink represent the 20 poorest school districts (i.e. higher aid ratios) and the 20 districts highlighted in green represent the most wealthy school districts (i.e. lower aid ratios).
- Average Expenditure Per Student = Total expenditures divided by the total number of students (ADM). The average expenditure per student is \$14,127.

Aid Ratio = One measure of relative wealth of a district. It is calculated using market value and personal income. A higher aid ratio indicates a poorer district; a lower aid ratio indicates a wealthier district. Regardless of wealth, no district is assigned an aid ratio lower than 0.1500; the highest aid ratio (poorest) is 0.8807. The average aid ratio is 0.5530.

#### **Red Column**

- The "Total Funding" column represents the total amount each school district received during Gov. Corbett's tenure (2011/12 through the proposed 2014/15 budget) in the five classroom subsidies. The five classroom subsidies include: Basic Education Subsidy, Accountability Block Grant (Ready to Learn Grant), Charter School Reimbursement, Education Assistance Program, and School Improvement Grants.
  - For 2010/11, only the ARRA (federal stimulus) funding that was appropriated through the basic subsidy formula is included, which is the portion of funding the Department of Education instructed school districts to consider "being built into the state's funding base". The 2010/11 enacted basic subsidy formula included \$5.12 billion in state funds and \$654 million in federal stimulus funds, for a total of \$5.77 billion. However, in 2011/12, Gov. Corbett retroactively used \$388 million in federal Education Jobs Fund monies to reduce the state funds. This resulted in an even lower state spend of \$4.73 billion and an even higher federal spend of \$1.04 billion.
  - In 2010/11, the enacted Accountability Block Grant was \$254 million; for 2011/12 through 2013/14, the grant was \$100 million; and for the proposed 2014/15 budget, the Ready to Learn Grant (which includes the Accountability Block Grant) is \$341 million. However, in Gov. Corbett's first budget, in an effort to reduce the total for general fund spending, a retroactive \$100 million appropriation was made to the Accountability Block Grant. As such, on budget spreadsheets, the grant appears as \$354 million for 2010/11 and \$0 for 2011/12. (We give Gov. Corbett credit for the \$100 million in 2011/12.)
- Note: Gov. Corbett eliminated or reduced a number of other appropriations, including Dual Enrollment and Science: It's Elementary;
   however, those amounts are not included in the spreadsheet.

#### **Orange Columns**

- The "Total Funding" column shows the total amount each district would have received from 2011/12 through 2014/15 if Gov. Corbett had flat-funded the five subsidies at 2008/09 levels. Note: 2008/09 is the fiscal year PRIOR to federal stimulus funding.
- The "\$ Difference" column shows the difference between what the district received compared to what they would have received if Gov. Corbett would have flat-funded education at the 2008/09 level.
- The "Difference Per Student" column calculates the dollar difference in funding for each student in the school district.

#### **Green Columns**

- The "**Total Funding**" column shows the total amount each district **would have** received from 2011/12 through 2014/15 if Gov. Corbett had flat-funded the five subsidies at 2010/11 levels.
- The "\$ Difference" column shows the difference between what the district received compared to what they would have received if Gov. Corbett would have flat-funded education at the 2010/11 level.
- The "Difference Per Student" column calculates the dollar difference in funding for each student in the school district.
